

OBSTETRICIAN AND GYNAECOLOGIST

Key Responsibilities and Activities

1. Collect, record and maintain patient information, such as medical histories, reports and examination results.
2. Care for and treat women during prenatal, natal and postnatal period.
3. Prescribe or administer therapy, medication and other specialized medical care to treat or prevent illness, disease or injury.
4. Perform Caesarean Sections or other surgical procedures as needed to preserve patients health and deliver babies safely..
5. Analyze records, reports, test results or examination information to diagnose medical condition of patient.
6. Explain Procedures and discuss test results or prescribed treatments with patients.
7. Monitor patient's conditions and progress and re-evaluate treatments as necessary.
8. Advise patients and community members concerning diet, hygiene and disease prevention.
9. Refer patients to Medical Specialist or other practitioner when necessary.
10. Direct and coordinate activities of Nurses, Students, Assistants, Specialists, Therapists and other Medical Staff.
11. Consult with or Provide Consulting services to other physician.
12. Plan, implement or administer health programs in Hospitals, Businesses or communities for prevention and treatment of injuries or illnesses.
13. Prepare government and Organizational reports on birth, death and disease statistics, workforce evaluations or Medical status of Individuals.
14. Conduct research to develop or test medications, treatments or procedures to prevent or control disease

Qualification

1. Be a holder of Masters of Medicine Obstetrics and Gynaecology from recognized Institution.
2. Must be registered with Uganda Medical and Dental Practitioners Council with a valid running practicing License.
